Masses at the chapel are celebrated in Latin (Ordinary 4 Form) on Fridays and at 11:45 AM on Sunday in accordance with the unbroken tradition of the Roman Tuesday, December 13 **Catholic Church.** 

"Particular law remaining in force, the use of the Latin 12:05 PM language is to be preserved in the Latin rites." (Vatican II, 4:45 PM Sacrosanctum Concilium, n. 36)

"Pastors of souls should take care that besides the vernacular Wednesday, December 14 'the faithful may also be able to say or sing together in Latin 8:00 those parts of the Ordinary Form of the Mass which pertain to 12:0 them."'(Sacred Congregation of Rites, Musicam Sacram 4:45 (1967), n. 47)
