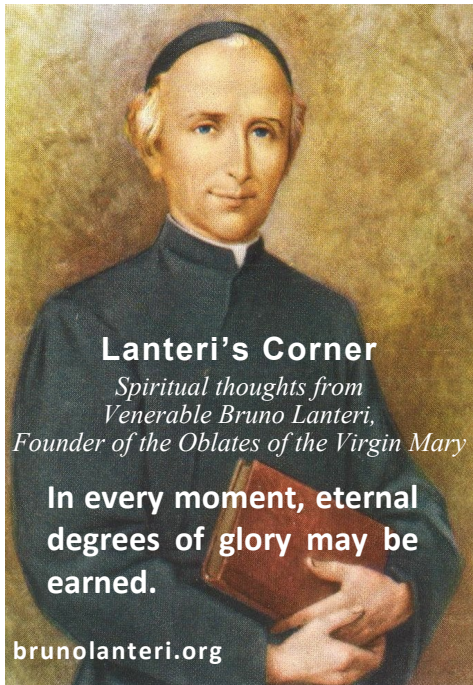

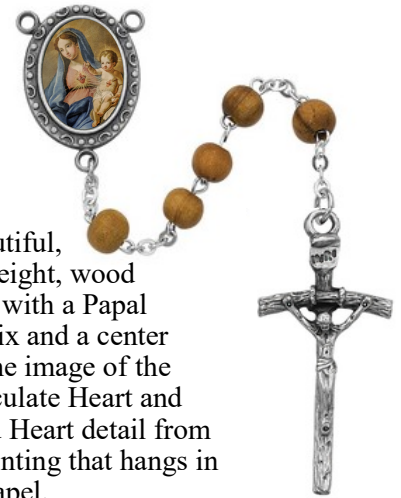

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Last week we celebrated an **event**; Pentecost, the birthday of the Church. Jesus sent His Holy Spirit to give the Apostles the courage to carry out their mission; to forgive sins and to preach.

We have celebrated other **events** lately; Easter and the Ascension of Our Lord into heaven. But today we celebrate a **truth**, a Catholic **doctrine**, that God is three Persons, one God. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit have one Mind, one Will and one Power. When we baptize, or bless ourselves, we do not say in the names of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit but in the **Name**. The Name is singular because the three Persons are one God, one Power. They are distinct Persons but they are **so intimately united** that they are never separated. The Father eternally begot the Son. That means the Son has always existed with the Father. It is not as if the Father existed first then the Son came along later. No they are all Eternal. And they have loved one another forever. We were created in the image of God. We are able to think, like God. We are able to remember, like God. We are able to love, like God.

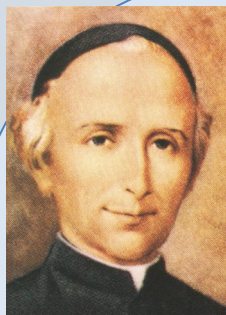

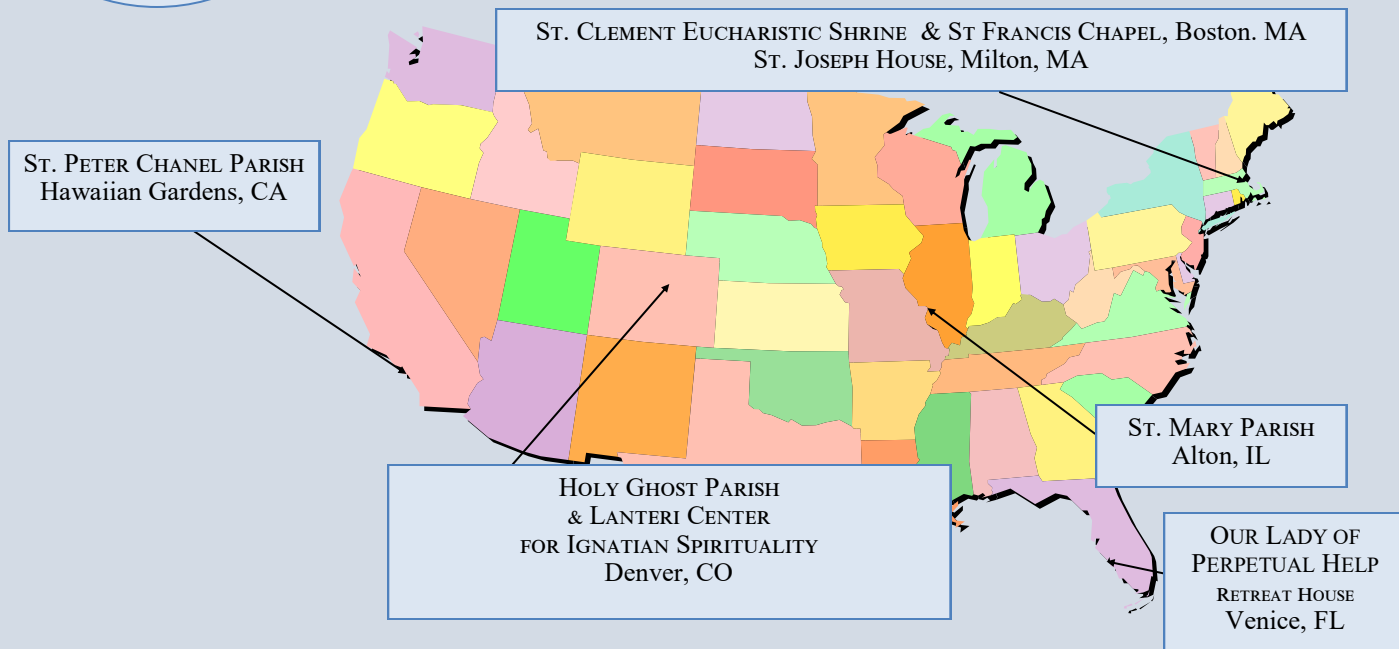

The OMV US Province House is at St. Clement’s in Boston.



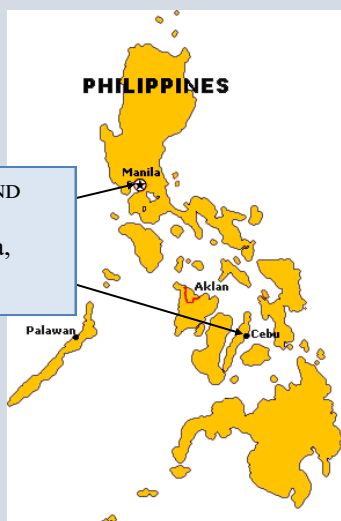
