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Reflection by Fr. James Doran , OMV

July is the month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Christ. Where do we get this term Precious Blood? We get it from the first Roman Catholic Pope, in his first encyclical. We find it in the New Testament, 1st Letter of St. Peter, verse 18-19; *you were ransomed from your futile conduct, handed on by your ancestors, not with perishable things like silver or gold* ¹⁹ *but with the precious blood of Christ as of a spotless unblemished Lamb.* Why does he call Christ's Blood 'precious'? Precious means of great value. It is greatly desired. It is held in the highest esteem. His Blood is precious because It is the price of our Salvation.

Pope St. Peter says, you *were ransomed from your futile conduct, handed on by your ancestors…* Ransomed means bought back. We were in the devil's power because of Original sin and actual sin, and the debt was death. As Fr. Hardon said, all the deaths of the human beings since the beginning of time would not have been enough to pay off the debt of the sin of our first parents and all the sins committed since because an Infinite Being was offended. And only an infinite Being could provide adequate ransom to redeem. He paid the ransom *not with perishable things like silver or gold* ¹⁹ *but with the precious blood of Christ as of a spotless unblemished Lamb*. Human Life is precious. The Life of God is infinitely precious. When we adore the Blood of Christ, we adore our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. When we receive the Consecrated Host, we also receive His Precious Blood, Soul and Divinity. We need not drink from the Chalice to drink the Blood. The Body and Blood are inseparable.

The Angel of Portugal gave the Host to Lucia, the Chalice to the other two. When Jacinta asked what she received Lucia said 'Didn't you see the drop of Blood from the Host to the Chalice? You received Holy Communion.' Here is an invocation most appropriate; *Blood of Christ, Eucharistic Drink, and refreshment of souls- Save us.*

An excellent method to ponder and praise this *Price of our Salvation* is to meditate on the 24 invocations in the Litany of the Precious Blood. The Litany is a way to adore and make thanksgiving and ask for the Grace of Salvation. After each of the 24 invocations, we respond "*Save us*".

St. Clement I, about 96 A.D. "Let us fix our gaze on the Blood of Christ and realize how truly precious It is, seeing that it was poured out for our salvation and brought the grace of conversion to the whole world."

Blood of Christ, price of our salvation, save us. Blood of Christ, without which there is no forgiveness, save us. Blood of Christ, Eucharistic drink and refreshment of souls, save us.
