

## Reflection by Fr. Isaac Abu, OMV

### *Journey Home from a Far Country*

Our scriptural texts today remind us about how humans are prone to sin and how desperately we need the mercy of God on the one hand, and on the other hand, how God is ever ready to lavish mercy upon us. After all, God did so for the Israelites in Egypt when their thanksgiving to him was to fashion a golden image for themselves as their god. However, He relented upon the intercession of Moses on their behalf. King David, a man after God's own heart, derailed big time! But he pleaded (Psalm 51), and he was pardoned. We see in these instances the beauty inherent in repentance the journey home to the Father after a change of mind.

It is always a pleasure to know that the Father's embrace is available for all who come back home after living in a far country of sin. The parable of the prodigal son brings this out beautifully.

Enjoying the warmth of the Father's embrace requires some actions from us. The willingness to constantly be in His embrace and, if, for some reason, we stray, the readiness to return to it. A constant reflection on ourselves is a great help towards ascertaining our state of life at a given moment in order to undergo transformation and become fully alive. John White buttressed this thus:

"Coming to ourselves, aligning ourselves with the moral structure of the universe, facing up to reality is always, in essence, going back to Godwhether we call it that or not for his were the hands that shaped us in our mothers' wombs. Returning to him, for the first time or the fiftieth, can be hard, but there is no other way to a profound and positive change or character." (John White: Changing on the Inside. 1991).

Pride is an obstacle that sometimes prevents this all-important journey to freedom. The word sorry is simple, but it can be difficult to say. Upon realizing how far he was from freedom, the Prodigal son said to himself, I must leave this place and go to my Father. That bold but humble step of return earned him full restoration of his sonship and brought him back to life.

There is always rejoicing in heaven when a sinner repents. The journey home is always a reason for celebration here on earth and in heaven. Therefore let us not be tired of journeying to and remaining in Father's embrace and doing all we can to promote the constant return of our brethren to the Father from far away countries.




