## Reflection by Fr. Isaac Abu, OMV

It is Epiphany! It is the culmination of Christmas!

Let us rejoice because we have finally gotten an answer to our prayer, which says:

Drop down dew, ve heavens. from the end let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened and bring forth a savior. (Isa. 45:8)

Something marvelous has happened, and an incredible movement has taken place.



The Divine has descended to meet with Humans. Consequently, humanity is elevated to be with the divine. Let us celebrate! For "unto you is born this day, in the city of David, a Savior who is Christ the Lord,"

Did he bring us a gift, we may ask? Yes, he did! What gift? He brought us Peace. As we know very well, peace is a precious gift. With peace, one can easily get all the gifts one may desire and be fully satisfied while using them. "Peace is the gift that Jesus Christ brought us from Heaven. His gift, the gift of God; a gift so beautiful, profound, all-embracing, so efficacious that we shall never truly comprehend it." 
