#### Reflection by Fr. Jonas Verdeflor, OMV Ever Bountiful Mercy of God

"You gave your children good ground for hope that you would permit repentance for their sins" (Wisdom 12:19).

Today's first reading sings of God's mercy. The walls of this very chapel would do the same. Our website states, "Saint Francis Chapel is a spiritual refuge for visitors, travelers, residents and workers in the heart of historic Back Bay Boston."

The Oblates of the Virgin Mary at the St. Francis Chapel have offered generous



hours of Confession for many decades. Daily, penitents near and far have availed themselves of God's mercy. Some come regularly while others rediscover Confession after so many years away. Although I have been a priest for slightly over a month, I have been humbled in my hours in the confessional. This week's first reading succinctly describes my mission: "But though you are master of might, you judge with clemency, and with much lenience you govern us for power, whenever you will, attends you" (Wisdom 12:18).

Mercy and power mutually support one another. Mercy is possible because of divine power. That power serves mercy by giving it freely to all. All that is symbolized by the Cross. Jesus forgives with his divine power, but he gave freely from the Cross. People come with their struggles to the confessional. Through the words and power from Jesus, I seek to encourage people to rely more on Jesus' mercy. The words of absolution ("And I absolve you from your sins ...) launch people into a new beginning with Jesus.

My brief time at the chapel draws toward a close. But God's mercy never ceases. May that mercy soak and transform your heart so everyone who sees you sees the merciful Jesus.
