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

Sacrifice!

Peter the Rock, who answered correctly the question asked by Jesus: Who do you say I am? Today, Peter has become a stumbling block to the salvific mission of Christ that will be accomplished through the Cross. Hence, His stern rebuke: "Get behind me Satan." In other words, get out of the way that leads to a wrong direction and follow from behind.

Peter's negative reaction to the prediction of Christ about what he must undergo indicated that he misunderstood the nature of Christ's messiahship. Besides, it demonstrated the rejection of sacrifice. But Christ, who draws good out of every experience, used the occasion to enlighten and clarify to his disciples the nature of true discipleship. He enumerated three areas: self denial, carrying of the cross and following him. Following the earlier question about Christ's identity, we may ask who is truly a disciple?

A disciple is a person who must be ready for sacrifice like Christ who sacrifices himself. He took our place and allowed himself to be condemned. Sacrificing for us, he received the punch that would have crushed us for us to live. A true disciple, therefore, is a believer who is Christlike in every sphere of his or her life. A disciple is the person who is aware that the cross is an inevitable component of our life in general and our Christian life in particular. Hence the preparedness to carry the cross as Christ did is a major aspect of discipleship. "Take up your cross and follow Me" is a real invitation that every Christian must embrace. Christ made very clear to us the inevitability of the cross when he said: "in the world you will have troubles [the cross] but be of good cheer. I have overcome the world" (Jn.16:33). Discipleship is synonymous with carrying the cross. The absence of cross in our lives therefore is indicative of the possibility of compromise. Doing the right thing, in the right way, as directed by God, in this depraved world, is a sure way of making the cross readily available. Its absence therefore demands a proper reality check to determine whether Christ is at the center of the individual's life.

Discipleship by its very nature presupposes the presence of a master. In this case, the Master is Jesus Christ. He leads the way, and everyone is to follow. He knows the way, clearly sees everything visible and invisible by virtue of his divine nature. It is proper that we all follow his directions to arrive at our destination.

By this statement, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me," Christ is inviting us to a life of constant sacrifice, that enables us to intentionally choose a life centered on gospel values, so as to do the same things He did.
