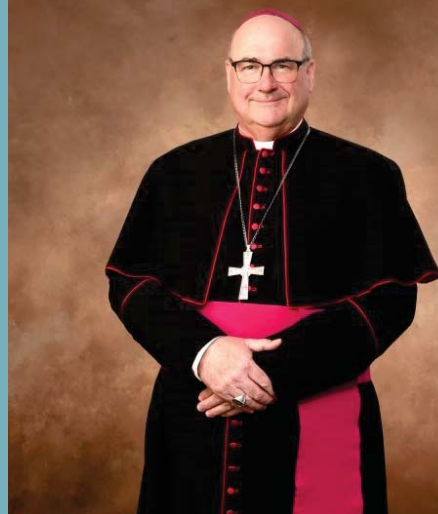

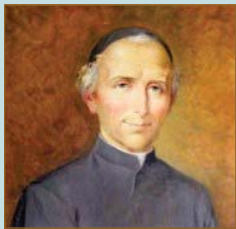

### *Prayer Before Mass by Venerable Bruno Lanteri, Founder of the OMV*

My God, I offer you this holy sacrifice to proclaim, honor and glorify your infinite greatness, and in recognition of the supreme dominion which, as the first principle and last end, you have above all created things. I give you this homage for all those who still do not know you or do not want to recognize you.

I offer this too in thanksgiving for the benefits that I and all the world have received and will receive from your infinite goodness; in satisfaction for my sins and those of the whole world; to implore the graces that are necessary for my eternal salvation and for all mankind. Oh, my God, I offer to you the merits of Jesus Christ; grant me at this Holy Mass a profound adoration of him.

My God, my Creator, I implore you to grant me the grace of final perseverance. I know by faith that I do not deserve it, nor can I deserve it, but your Divine Son deserves it for me with all his virtues and with all the wounds he shows you in his Most Holy Body, on behalf of my wounded love. Amen.

## CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

**965** After her Son's Ascension, Mary "aided the beginnings of the Church by her prayers."<sup>506</sup> In her association with the apostles and several women, "we also see Mary by her prayers imploring the gift of the Spirit, who had already overshadowed her in the Annunciation."<sup>507</sup>

### ... also in her Assumption

**966** "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death."<sup>508</sup> The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians:

*In giving birth you kept your virginity; in your Dormition you did not leave the world, O Mother of God, but were joined to the source of Life. You conceived the living God and, by your prayers, will deliver our souls from death.*

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, this coming Thursday, August 15, the Church invites us to honor Mama Mary as we lovingly celebrate A Holy Day of Obligation - The Solemnity of her Assumption into Heaven. As with every Marian blessing, we honor God's work of grace in Her, and in the Assumption, the completion of his work in her by which Jesus came into the world and saved us from our sins and restored to us the gift and mystery of eternal life. There are 8 Masses here including the vigil Mass on August 14th (also the feast of St Maximilian Kolbe). Please see the schedule or be sure to attend your own parish that day! What wouldn't I do to honor my Mother!

We also celebrate the Providence of God in providing for us, the sheep of his flock, with Shepherds. This past Monday Pope Francis announced the retirement of our Archbishop, Sean Cardinal O'Malley and our next Archbishop, Bishop Richard Henning, currently the Bishop of Providence, Rhode Island. We are grateful to God for the many years that Cardinal O'Malley has shepherded this archdiocese, and for his care for and love of the Chapel and our OMV Community here in Boston. Cardinal O'Malley has visited us here at the Chapel a number of times over the years and I hope to have him back one more time before he leaves, if his schedule allows. We look forward to meeting Archbishop Henning when he comes to Boston and becomes our Shepherd. I think it's significant that he comes from Providence. God provides all good things in his Divine Providence and makes all things work together unto the good.

Since I became director of the Chapel two months ago, I've learned about our dependence on God's Providence in a very real way. God keeps the Chapel here and open through your goodness. Thank you! As you might imagine, real estate here in the Mall is not inexpensive, and paying all the bills costs more than ever. Here are the principal ways God provides for us: Mass collections, (including the box by the door), online donations (including the QR codes), major gifts, candles, the kiosks in the vestibule, the gift shop (check it out!) and the Benefactors Memorial Tree in the vestibule. Thank you for your support of our ministry here. We are not able to be here without you! God bless you! Our Lady of the Assumption, pray for us! St Maximilian Kolbe, pray for us!

## Cardinal's Message to the Archdiocese of Boston

Dear Friends,

On Monday, August 5, 2024 the Holy Father announced that he has named the Most Reverend Richard G. Henning, S.T.D. as the tenth bishop and seventh archbishop of the Archdiocese of Boston. Archbishop-elect Henning is currently the Bishop of the Diocese of Providence.

On behalf of the entire Archdiocese of Boston, including our priests, religious, deacons, and laity we welcome Archbishop-elect Richard Henning. We extend our deep gratitude to the Holy Father for this appointment demonstrating his ongoing pastoral care for the people of the Archdiocese. I look forward to our people and the wider community getting to know our new Archbishop-elect in the days, weeks, months and years ahead. He ministers with the heart of a pastor with a sincere commitment to serving Christ and the Church.

Archbishop-elect Henning will be installed as Archbishop of Boston on Thursday, October 31, 2024, at the Cathedral of the Holy Cross in Boston, MA. Additional details to follow.

Archbishop-elect Henning has asked us to share his initial comments with you on his appointment:

"I am grateful to His Holiness Pope Francis for his confidence in me and for his conferral of this new mission as Archbishop of Boston. I receive this appointment relying upon divine Providence, aware that this is the Lord's Church and that I am no more than an unworthy servant.

I would also like to express my gratitude to His Eminence Cardinal Sean O'Malley who has served the Church of Boston for many faithful and joyful years.

Greetings to the clergy and faithful of Boston. I ask your prayers that I may cling to the Lord's Holy Cross, honor His mother, imitate His saints, and love you as His people and His ministers." We adore You and praise You O Christ, for by Your Holy Cross You have redeemed the world.

Certainly, I have much left to express to you all about my gratitude for my 21 years as your shepherd. I will reserve those words for a time closer to the end of my assignment as your Archbishop. Today is a day of celebration and prayer as we welcome the Holy Father's assignment of Archbishop-elect Henning to the Archdiocese. I ask that you pray for him as he begins to plan for this transition. In the meantime, please be assured of my continued prayers for all of you.

I ask you therefore to dispose of me according to your desire as my true and absolute Lady.

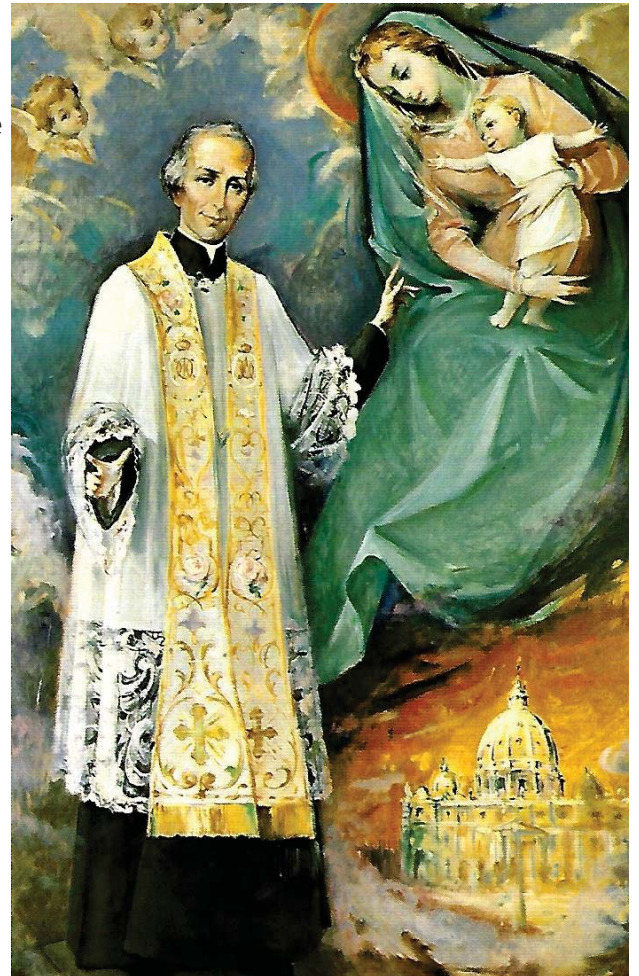

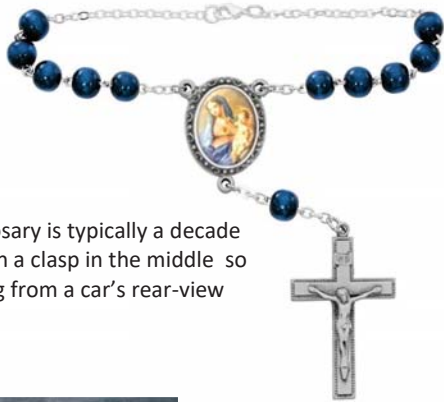

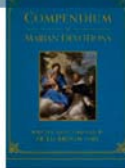
