The Pope's Prayer Intention for December:



Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Brothers and sisters:

"Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice!" Happy Gaudete Sunday! Today, on the Third Sunday of Advent we rejoice that the celebration of the birth of Jesus is near and also that we are closer as a Church and world to his glorious Second Coming. Rejoice!

As the crowds, the tax collectors and the soldiers in today's Gospel asked "What must I do?" So do we ask the same question. Some of the answers are: "Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none. And whoever has food should do likewise." "Stop collecting more than what is prescribed." "Do not practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with your wages."

And as we hear these answers to what we must do, we're able to embrace them and act on them and change our hearts, attitudes and lives. We can make these changes with rejoicing, because the Lord is near and he will give us his transforming Grace, and so St Paul tells us: "Brothers and sisters: Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice! Your kindness should be known to all. The Lord is near." The Lord is near with his love and grace. There are 10 days until Christmas, Why not pray over the Ten Commandments and make a good confession? What must I do? Begin Again.


Note: Food/drink at rest stops is the participant's responsibility.
