

Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Chapel Brothers and Sisters in the Newborn King,

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph and this Wednesday, January 1, New Years Day, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary (A Holy Day of Obligation - see the Mass Schedule here in the bulletin).

I pray that your Christmas is and has been blessed and the New Year as well! I have been here at the Chapel for six months now, and what a blessing it has been for me. Pondering the Holy Family, it really strikes me that the Chapel is very unique among various places of Catholic worship such as parishes and shrines. Even though we are not a parish and much of our population is transitory (we don't celebrate the full array of the Catholic Sacramental life—no baptisms, confirmations, first holy communions, weddings or funerals—and we don't do much in the way of formation—no prayer groups, catechism, youth group, senior group, etc), I have a profound sense that we are still a family here at the Chapel. I see it, above all, in the devotion: seeking of mercy, faith and love in you all; your devotion to the Sacramental life that we offer here—the nearly 30 Masses and 40 hours of Confession availability here each week. I see it in the people who come and pray and adore the Lord here daily, in the people with whom I am able to speak with in the gift shop and after Masses and around the chapel here in the Pru, who ask for prayers and blessings, who share their needs and intentions with me and ask us for prayers. I see it in the generosity of our staff and in the volunteers and all who offer to help with their prayers and generosity toward keeping the Chapel up and running, open and beautiful. Yes we are the Family of God, part of his Holy Family under the love and care of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, St. Francis and Venerable Bruno Lanteri, the founder of the OMV. Yes! Happy Feast of the Holy Family! And may we all continue to grow together in holiness in the love and mercy of our Newborn King, Jesus Christ!

Catechism of the Catholic Church on the Holy Theotokos-Mother of God

Mary's divine motherhood

495 Called in the Gospels "the mother of Jesus," Mary is acclaimed by Elizabeth, at the prompting of the Spirit and even before the birth of her son, as "the mother of my Lord." In fact, the One whom she conceived as man by the Holy Spirit, who truly became her Son according to the flesh, was none other than the Father's eternal Son, the second person of the Holy Trinity. Hence the Church confesses that Mary is truly "Mother of God" (*Theotokos*). 145]

Mary's virginal motherhood in God's plan

502 The eyes of faith can discover in the context of the whole of Revelation the mysterious reasons why God in his saving plan wanted his Son to be born of a virgin. These reasons touch both on the person of Christ and his redemptive mission, and on the welcome Mary gave that mission on behalf of all men.


503 Mary's virginity manifests God's absolute initiative in the Incarnation. Jesus has only God as Father. "He was never estranged from the Father because of the human nature which he assumed ... He is naturally Son of the Father as to his divinity and naturally son of his mother as to his humanity, but properly Son of the Father in both natures." [161]

504 Jesus is conceived by the Holy Spirit in the Virgin Mary's womb because he is the New Adam, who inaugurates the new creation: "The first man was from the earth, a man of dust; the second man is from heaven." From his conception, Christ's humanity is filled with the Holy Spirit, for God "gives him the Spirit without measure." From "his fullness" as the head of redeemed humanity "we have all received, grace upon grace."

505 By his virginal conception, Jesus, the New Adam, ushers in *the new birth* of children adopted in the Holy Spirit through faith. "How can this be?"[165] Participation in the divine life arises "not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God."[166] The acceptance of this life is virginal because it is entirely the Spirit's gift to man. The spousal character of the human vocation in relation to God[167] is fulfilled perfectly in Mary's virginal motherhood.

506 Mary is a virgin because her virginity is *the sign of her faith* "unadulterated by any doubt," and of her undivided gift of herself to God's will. It is her faith that enables her to become the mother of the Savior: "Mary is more blessed because she embraces faith in Christ than because she conceives the flesh of Christ." [169]

507 At once virgin and mother, Mary is the symbol and the most perfect realization of the Church: "the Church indeed ... by receiving the word of God in faith becomes herself a mother. By preaching and Baptism she brings forth sons, who are conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of God, to a new and immortal life. She herself is a virgin, who keeps in its entirety and purity the faith she pledged to her spouse." [170]


