



In addition to this Chapel, the OMV serve at St Clement Eucharistic Shrine a few blocks from here, which is also our US Seminary, in Milton MA at our St. Joseph Retreat House as well as in Los Angeles, CA, Denver, CO, Alton, IL and Venice, FL. Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Baptismal Brothers and Sisters,

Blessings on your celebration of the Baptism of the Lord Jesus! The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 536) teaches us that "The baptism of Jesus is on his part the acceptance and inauguration of his mission as God's suffering Servant. He allows himself to be numbered among sinners; he is already "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". Already he is anticipating the "baptism" of his bloody death. Already he is coming to "fulfil all righteousness", that is, he is submitting himself entirely to his Father's will: out of love he consents to this baptism of death for the remission of our sins." Jesus, the Son of God and sinless did not need baptism, but shows us how to begin our sharing in his life, in our Baptism, being claimed by God, as water is poured over our head and the priest says, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Truly at that moment too, our almighty and merciful father looked upon each one of us and said 'Behold, my beloved.' Tomorrow begins ordinary time until Wednesday, March 5, when we begin our Lenten Journey toward Christ's salvific passion, death and resurrection. Please take some time to ponder God's goodness, that in your baptism he loves you so much, that he has claimed you as his own, and has given you every grace and gift you need to grow, remain and thrive in holiness! Renew your trust in his mercy for you and his providence and try to surrender and trust and even more in Him in the coming year.



- Go to confession to return to your baptismal state of holiness
- Have pasta shells for dinner (shells are a traditional symbol of baptism)

V. Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?




