

Miracles occur in the confessional. In addition to this Chapel, the OMV serve at St Clement Eucharistic Shrine a few blocks from here, which is also our US Seminary, in Milton MA at our St. Joseph Retreat House as well as in Los Angeles, CA, Denver, CO, Alton, IL and Venice, FL. 

# Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Brothers and Sisters, builders of God's Kingdom and St Francis Chapel,

This Monday, February 3, at 7 AM we begin the renovation of St Francis Chapel in earnest. With your prayers, the renovation will be done in 5 days. This coming week from Monday to Friday, all daily Masses will be offered at the usual times (8:00, 12:05, 4:45) on the Fifth Floor of the Sheraton Hotel in the Public Garden Room. You may follow the signage from the entrance of the Sheraton nearest to the Chapel. The Chapel itself will be closed as painting, a new floor and other updates are completed. There will be no Adoration this week. Masses in the Chapel will resume in the Chapel Saturday, February 8.

Please pray for this wonderful undertaking. The present Chapel was built and dedicated in 1993, but our presence here dates back 55 years to 1969 and it's been many years since the chapel was painted and other important updates undertaken. These past few weeks the candle walls were scrubbed and restored in large part to their original beauty, although an argument can be made for the beauty of candle soot and its measure of the millions of prayers offered here over the years. Some repairs were made to the carpet and the HVAC vents were cleaned throughout the Chapel. The total cost of this renovation is over \$40,000. including our rental of space for the week of Masses in the Sheraton. A benefactor has provided more than half of this amount. Another expense in the back of my mind, as I had to repair some of our HVAC system this past week, is the eventuality of a new HVAC system altogether, which I have begun to look into. The present system dates to 1993.

Thank you all for your prayers and financial generosity toward the Chapel. Without both we are not here. Since I assumed the leadership of the Chapel last year, I have not ceased to be amazed at the wonders that God works here in the lives and journeys of all who pass through our doors. May the renovation of this Chapel be a sign of the renewal, refreshment and increase of God's love taking place in each one of us!



A mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, constructores del Reino de Dios y de la Capilla de San Francisco,


Este lunes 3 de febrero a las 7 a.m., comenzaremos la renovación de la Capilla de San Francisco. Con la Gracia de Dios y sus oraciones, dicha renovación estará lista en 5 días. En tal sentido, la próxima semana, de lunes a viernes, todas las Misas diarias se ofrecerán en los horarios habituales (8:00, 12:05, 4:45) en el quinto piso del Hotel Sheraton en el "Public Garden Room". También pueden seguir la señalización que estará en la entrada del Sheraton, más próxima a la Capilla. Es importante destacar que la misma permanecerá cerrada durante el tiempo señalado, en la medida en que finalicen las tareas que ello conlleva (pintura, cambio de piso, entre otros). En tal sentido, esta semana no habrá Adoración; por lo tanto, las misas en la Capilla se reanudarán el sábado 8 de febrero.

Por favor oren para que este maravilloso proyecto sea una realidad. Es interesante saber que esta (nuestra) Capilla fue construida y dedicada en 1993, sin embargo, nuestra presencia aquí se remonta a hace 55 años, a 1969; y ya han pasado muchos años desde que se pintó la capilla y se realizaron los arreglos concernientes. Estas últimas Semanas, limpiaron las paredes de las velas fueron limpiadas y restauradas en gran parte a su belleza original, aunque se puede argumentar a favor de la belleza del hollín de las velas y su medida de los millones de oraciones ofrecidas aquí a lo largo de los años. Se hicieron algunas reparaciones a la alfombra y se limpiaron las rejillas de ventilación HVAC en toda la Capilla. El costo total de esta renovación supera los \$40,000, incluido nuestro alquiler de espacio para la semana de Misas en el Sheraton. Un benefactor ha aportado más de la mitad de esta cantidad. Otro gasto que tengo en mente, ya que tuve que reparar parte de nuestro sistema HVAC la *Continúa en la página siguiente*

semana pasada, es la eventualidad de un sistema HVAC completamente nuevo, que he comenzado a considerar. El sistema actual data de 1993.

Gracias a todos por sus oraciones y generosidad financiera hacia la Capilla. Sin ambos no estamos aquí. Desde que asumí el liderazgo de la Capilla el año pasado, no he dejado de sorprenderme por las maravillas que Dios obra aquí en las vidas y viajes de todos los que pasan por nuestras puertas. ¡Que la renovación de esta Capilla sea signo de la renovación, refrigerio y aumento del amor de Dios que se produce en cada uno de nosotros!


### Oración por los hombres y mujeres consagrados


# St. Clement Amicizia Cristiana
