

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For our Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we have 2,000 palms on hand which will be blessed, distributed, held and pondered during the 9 Palm Sunday Masses here at the chapel. We will all hold these palms during the Mass during the proclamation of the Palm Sunday Gospel at the beginning of the Mass and also during our shared proclamation of the Gospel passion narrative. The blessed palms are a concrete way for you and me to enter into the great mystery of Holy Week and the Sacred days of the Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Praying with these palms here in Church at home and along the way, we might make these sentiments of Venerable Bruno Lanteri, the founder of the OMV, our own: "Moreover, they did not go with empty hands, but carrying palms which signify victories, and olive branches which represent peace. So I bring them to my Jesus: peace with Him and with one's neighbor, that is, peace of conscience and victories over vices corrected, passions subdued, inclinations and repugnances to the good overcome. And I will not be content to bring Him leaves, that is, simple intentions, but fruits." (Please find the rest of Fr Lanteri's meditation elsewhere in the bulletin.) May the Lord bless your steps into Holy Week and the inestimable love of Jesus Christ for you. Suggestion: another gift you can bring to Jesus this Holy Week is all your sins in a good confession. 
Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Para nuestro Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor, tenemos 2000 palmas disponibles que serán bendecidas, distribuidas, sostenidas y meditadas durante las nueve misas del Domingo de Ramos aquí en la capilla. Todos las sostendremos durante la proclamación del Evangelio del Domingo de Ramos al comienzo de la misa y también durante nuestra proclamación compartida del relato evangélico de la pasión. Las palmas benditas son una manera concreta para que ustedes y yo nos adentremos en el gran misterio de la Semana Santa y los días sagrados del Triduo del Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Sábado Santo. Orando con estas palmas aquí en la Iglesia, en casa y a lo largo del camino, podemos hacer nuestros estos sentimientos del Venerable Bruno Lanteri, fundador de la OMV: "Además, no iban con las manos vacías, sino llevando palmas que significan victorias y ramas de olivo que representan la paz. Así que las traigo a mi Jesús: paz con Él y con el prójimo, es decir, paz de conciencia y victorias sobre los vicios corregidos, pasiones sometidas, inclinaciones y repugnancias al bien vencidas. Venerable Bruno Lanteri on Communion and Jesus' Entrance into Jerusalem

S. John Chrysostom says that communion is a solemn entrance that Jesus does in the Christian soul, similar to what he did in Jerusalem. So I can use as a model what his good disciples did towards Jesus then. A crowd of the disciples, as the Evangelist says, in hearing that Jesus wanted to visit them publicly in the city, were happy and praised God. They were rejoicing and praising. So, first of all, knowing that the Lord wants to come into my soul, I will examine whether I am His true disciple by having His holy grace, by detesting everything that displeases Him, by practicing virtue, according to what S. Paul says: But man tests himself. And this being so, I rejoice within myself that the Lord wishes so much to favor me, to praise Him and thank Him for so much goodness.

Moreover, they were not content to wait for Him, but went to meet Him, just as I must go to meet my God, who meekly, hiding His majesty and His glory, comes to my soul with acts of faith, recognizing Him for what He truly is, of humility, very often presenting me with the centurion that I am not worthy of such a great visit,



with acts of contrition, detesting my sins and most ardent desires. Moreover, they did not go with empty hands, but carrying palms which signify victories, and olive branches which represent peace. So I bring them to my Jesus: peace with Him and with one's neighbor, that is, peace of conscience and victories over vices corrected, passions subdued, inclinations and repugnances to the good overcome. And I will not be content to bring Him leaves, that is, simple intentions, but fruits. Finally, after covering the streets where He passed with their clothes, they accompanied Him to the inn, stayed with Him for a long time, and did not leave until, after having healed the blind, the deaf, the lame, and all who were sick, He sent them away with His blessing.

Dice San Juan Crisóstomo que la comunión es una entrada solemne que hace Jesús en el alma cristiana, similar a la que hizo en Jerusalén. Así que puedo usar como modelo lo que sus buenos discípulos hicieron con Jesús entonces. Una multitud de los discípulos, como dice el evangelista, al oír que Jesús quería visitarlos públicamente en la ciudad, se alegraron y alabaron a Dios. Se regocijaban y alababan. Así que, ante todo, sabiendo que el Señor quiere venir a mi alma, examinaré si soy su verdadero discípulo teniendo su santa gracia, detestando todo lo que le desagrada, practicando la virtud, según lo que dice San Pablo: Pero el hombre se prueba a sí mismo. Y siendo esto así, me regocijo dentro de mí de que el Señor quiera tanto favorecerme, alabarlo y darle gracias por tanta bondad.

Además, no se contentaron con esperarlo, sino que fueron a su encuentro, como yo debo ir al encuentro de mi Dios, quien mansamente, ocultando su majestad y su gloria, viene a mi alma con actos de fe, reconociéndolo por lo que realmente es, de humildad, presentándome muy a menudo con el centurión de que no soy digno de tan gran visita, con actos de contrición, detestando mis pecados y deseos más ardientes. Además, no fueron con las manos vacías, sino portando palmas que significan victorias y ramas de olivo que representan la paz. Así que los traigo a mi Jesús: paz con Él y con el prójimo, es decir, paz de conciencia y victorias sobre los vicios corregidos, pasiones dominadas, inclinaciones y repugnancias al bien vencidas. Y no me contentaré con traerle hojas, es decir, simples intenciones, sino frutos. Finalmente, después de cubrir con sus ropas las calles por donde pasaba, le acompañaron hasta la posada, estuvieron con Él largo tiempo y no se fueron hasta que, después de haber curado a los ciegos, a los sordos, a los cojos y a todos los enfermos, los despidió con su bendición.




We're excited to welcome James Wahlberg as this year's keynote speaker!




