The Pope's Prayer Intention for April:

For the Use of the New Technologies

Let us pray that the use of the new technologies will not replace human relationships, will respect the dignity of the person, and will help us face the crises of our times.

Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Brothers and Sisters in the risen Lord Jesus, Alleluia!

A blessed and joyous Easter to you and yours! And a special welcome to our "Alleluia" runners! I am especially happy this Easter to be here at the Chapel. Since I arrived in June last year, there's been nothing but Easter blessings always! This is really a remarkable place, this Oblate of the Virgin Mary Chapel! God is really at work here at the Chapel, what Fr Andy calls the "Front porch of America, with the tallest bell tower!" Look up when you leave the chapel and you'll see our bell tower - the Prudential building!

The running of the Boston Marathon tomorrow, Easter Monday, provides us with some very interesting and apt images, inspiration and holy reminders. We can think of Peter and John running to the tomb only to find it empty. Or the disciples who encountered Jesus on the road to Emmaus running back to Jerusalem to share their news with the Apostles. Certainly St Paul's words are apropos: "Do you not know that the runners in the stadium all run in the race, but only one wins the prize? Run so as to win. Every athlete exercises discipline in every way. They do it to win a perishable crown, but we an imperishable one. Thus I do not run aimlessly; I do not fight as if I were shadowboxing No, I drive my body and train it, for fear that, after having preached to others, I myself should be disqualified." (1 Cor 9:24-27) And also, in his letter to the Hebrews 12:1-2: "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us rid ourselves of every burden and sin that clings to us and persevere in running the race that lies before us, while keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, the leader and perfecter of faith."

Alleluia! The Christian life is a race to be run, and more of a marathon than a sprint. We have beginning points, and begin-again points! Mile markers and heartbreak Hills! But there is also the Finish Line and all the glory that is promised there. May God give us all the grace to live Christ's resurrection. And to run and fight so as to win one day the imperishable crown of Heaven! Alleluia! He is Risen! Alleluia!

Así que no corro sin rumbo; no lUCHO como si estuviera boxeando con mi sombra. No, guío mi cuerpo y lo entreno, por temor a que, después de haber predicado a otros, yo mismo sea descalificado". (1 Cor 9:24-27) Y también, en su carta a los Hebreos 12:1-2: "Por tanto, teniendo en derredor nuestro tan gran nube de testigos, despojémonos de toda carga y del pecado que nos asedia, y corramos con

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy—Using a Standard Rosary

1. Make the Sign of the Cross:

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

2. Optional Opening Prayers

St. Faustina's Prayer for Sinners

O Jesus, eternal Truth, our Life, I call upon You and I beg Your mercy for poor sinners. O sweetest Heart of my Lord, full of pity and unfathomable mercy, I plead with You for poor sinners. O Most Sacred Heart, Fount of Mercy from which gush forth rays of inconceivable graces upon the entire human race, I beg of You light for poor sinners. O Jesus, be mindful of Your own bitter Passion and do not permit the loss of souls redeemed at so dear a price of Your most precious Blood. O Jesus, when I consider the great price of Your Blood, I rejoice at its immensity, for one drop alone would have been enough for the salvation of all sinners. Although sin is an abyss of wickedness and ingratitude, the price paid for us can never be equalled. Therefore, let every soul trust in the Passion of the Lord, and place its hope in His mercy. God will not deny His mercy to anyone. Heaven and earth may change, but God's mercy will never be exhausted. Oh, what immense joy burns in my heart when I contemplate Your incomprehensible goodness, O Jesus! I desire to bring all sinners to Your feet that they may glorify Your mercy throughout endless ages (*Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*, 72).

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. Our Father

4. Hail Mary

5. The Apostles' Creed

6. On the Large Bead for each Decade: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

10. Optional Closing Prayers

Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

O Greatly Merciful God, Infinite Goodness, today all mankind calls out from the abyss of its misery to Your mercy — to Your compassion, O God; and it is with its mighty voice of misery that it cries out. Gracious God, do not reject the prayer of this earth's exiles! O Lord, Goodness beyond our understanding, Who are acquainted with our misery through and through, and know that by our own power we cannot ascend to You, we implore You: anticipate us with Your grace and keep on increasing Your mercy in us, that we may faithfully do Your holy will all through our life and at death's hour. Let the omnipotence of Your mercy shield us from the darts of our salvation's enemies, that we may with confidence, as Your children, await Your [Son's] final coming — that day known to You alone. And we expect to obtain everything promised us by Jesus in spite of all our wretchedness. For Jesus is our Hope: through His merciful Heart, as through an open gate, we pass through to Heaven (*Diary*, 1570).

Oh Jesús, Verdad eterna, Vida nuestra, te invoco y te imploro misericordia por los pobres pecadores. Oh dulcísimo Corazón de mi Señor, lleno de piedad e insondable misericordia, te suplico por los pobres pecadores. Oh Sacratísimo Corazón, Fuente de Misericordia de la cual brotan rayos de gracias inconcebibles sobre toda la humanidad, te imploro luz para los pobres pecadores. Oh Jesús, recuerda tu amarga Pasión y no permitas que se pierdan las almas redimidas al precio tan alto de tu preciosísima Sangre. Oh Jesús, cuando considero el gran precio de tu Sangre, me regocijo por su inmensidad, pues una sola gota habría bastado para la salvación de todos los pecadores. Aunque el pecado es un abismo de maldad e ingratitud, el precio pagado por nosotros jamás podrá ser igualado. Por lo tanto, que cada alma confíe en la Pasión del Señor y ponga su esperanza en su misericordia. Dios no negará su misericordia a nadie. El cielo y la tierra pueden cambiar, pero la misericordia de Dios nunca se agotará. ¡Oh, qué inmensa alegría arde en mi corazón al contemplar tu incomprensible bondad, oh Jesús! Deseo traer a todos los pecadores a tus pies para que glorifiquen tu misericordia por los siglos de los siglos (Diario de Santa María Faustina Kowalska, 72).

5. Credo de los Apóstoles

6. En la Cuenta Grande de cada Decena: Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad de tu Amado Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en expiación por nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.

7. En las 10 Cuentas Pequeñas de cada Decena: Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.

8. Repetir para las demás decenas.

Rezando el "Padre Eterno" (6) en la cuenta del "Padre Nuestro" y luego 10 "Por su dolorosa Pasión" (7) en las siguientes cuentas del "Ave María".

9. Concluya con Santo Dios (Repita tres veces)

Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten piedad de nosotros y del mundo entero.

10. Oraciones de cierre opcionales

Dios eterno, en quien la misericordia es infinita y el tesoro de la compasión inagotable, míranos bondadosamente y aumenta tu misericordia en nosotros, para que en los momentos difíciles no desesperemos ni nos desanimemos, sino que con gran confianza nos sometamos a tu santa voluntad, que es Amor y Misericordia mismos.

Oh Dios Misericordioso, Bondad Infinita, hoy toda la humanidad clama desde el abismo de su miseria a tu misericordia, a tu compasión, oh Dios; y es con la poderosa voz de su miseria que clama. Dios misericordioso, no rechaces la oración de los exiliados de esta tierra. Oh Señor, Bondad incomprensible, que conoces nuestra miseria de pies a cabeza y sabes que por nuestras propias fuerzas no podemos ascender a ti, te imploramos: antícipate a nosotros con tu gracia y sigue aumentando tu misericordia en nosotros, para que cumplamos fielmente tu santa voluntad durante toda nuestra vida y en la hora de la muerte. Que la omnipotencia de tu misericordia nos proteja de los dardos de los enemigos de nuestra salvación, para que podamos esperar con confianza, como hijos tuyos, la venida final de tu Hijo, ese día que solo tú conoces. Y esperamos obtener todo lo que nos prometió Jesús a pesar de toda nuestra miseria. Porque Jesús es nuestra Esperanza: por su Corazón misericordioso, como por una puerta abierta, pasamos al Cielo (Diario, 1570).


