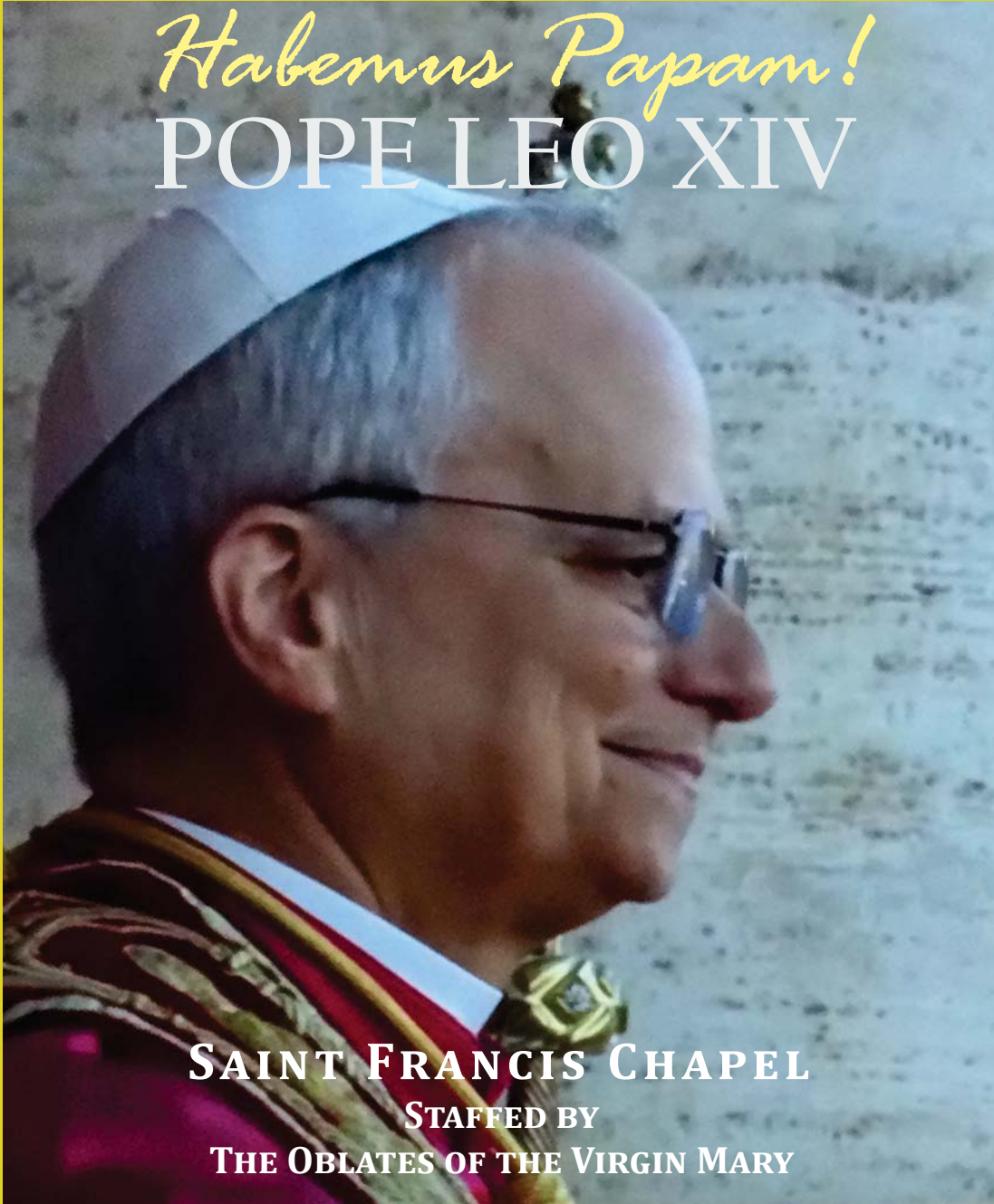

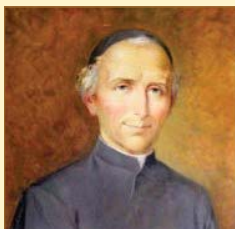

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Good Shepherd Sunday! Happy Mother's Day! Habemus Papam! Pope Leo XIV!

"Know that the LORD is God; he made us, his we are; his people, the flock he tends." We are his people, the sheep of his flock. There is nothing more important for us to remember and live by....we belong to God. He made us, his we are. Psalm 100 is one of my favorites. The revelation in it, and how happy it makes me to know who I am, who made me, and to whom I belong! Jesus, the Good Shepherd! And now we have a new Pope! Pope Leo XIV! May God bless our new Papa, our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, the successor of St Peter, the Vicar of Christ on Earth!

Happy Mother's day! Mothers are like shepherds. My mother was one in a very real way, and of a large flock. Elizabeth Ann was the mother of ten children, and at times an unruly flock. When she and my dad married in October 1954, they didn't know how big their flock was going to be, but they had faith in God and love for one another that carried them through 63 years together, and though all the difficulties and challenges that came their way (including the ones I regretfully gave to them!). My mother was devoted to the Good Shepherd and she knew where he resided, where he was to be found, where the safe sheepfold was - at Sunday (and often Daily) Mass, and in the Tabernacle in every Catholic Church. She used to say "Miles Melt before the Tabernacle," meaning, among other things, that when she and we were physically apart, that going into a catholic Church we could be one in the Eucharist in a very real way. Yes, the Good Shepherd is in the Tabernacle! He made us, we belong to him! Mom knew that, and she knew the need to stay close, indeed be united to, the good shepherd, because she and motherhood and life were, and are, under attack. Occasionally people would criticize her for having so many children, for being a mother to so many. Her reply? "Which one should I give back?" The Devil hates women, mothers, marriage, families, babies and life, He hates the Good Shepherd. Stay close to Jesus in the Tabernacle. Through Him, and with Him, and in Him, we will be safe and reach the eternal pasture in love and joy. There is no other way. Happy Good Shepherd Sunday! Happy Mother's Day! And in the first words of Pope Leo XIV to the Church and the world: "Peace be with all of you!"

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

¡Feliz Domingo del Buen Pastor! ¡Feliz Día de la Madre! Habemus Papam! ¡El Papa León XIV!

"Reconozcamos que el Señor es Dios, que él fue quien nos hizo y somos suyos, que somos su pueblo y su rebaño." El Señor es nuestro Dios y nosotros su pueblo. No hay nada más importante que recordar y vivir... pertenecemos a Dios. Él nos hizo, suyos somos. El Salmo 100 es uno de mis favoritos. La revelación que contiene, y la felicidad que me da saber quién soy, quién me hizo y a quién pertenezco. ¡Jesús, el Buen Pastor! ¡Y ahora tenemos un nuevo Papa! ¡El Papa León XIV! Que Dios bendiga a nuestro nuevo Papa, nuestro nuevo Santo Padre, el Papa León XIV, sucesor de San Pedro, el Vicario de Cristo en la Tierra.

¡Feliz Día de la Madre! Las madres son como pastoras. Mi madre lo era de verdad, y pertenecía a un rebaño numeroso. Elizabeth Ann era madre de diez hijos, y a veces de un rebaño rebelde. Cuando ella y mi padre se casaron en octubre de 1954, no sabían cuán grande sería su rebaño, pero tenían fe en Dios y amor mutuo que los llevó a través de 63 años juntos, y a través de todas las dificultades y desafíos que se les presentaron (¡incluyendo los que lamentablemente les di!). Mi madre era devota del Buen Pastor y sabía dónde residía, dónde se lo podía encontrar, dónde estaba el redil seguro: en la misa dominical (y a menudo diaria) y en el Sagrario de cada iglesia católica. Solía decir "Miles se derrite ante el Sagrario", queriendo decir, entre otras cosas, que cuando ella y nosotros estábamos físicamente separados, al ir a una iglesia católica podíamos ser uno en la Eucaristía de una manera muy real. ¡Sí, el Buen Pastor está en el Tabernáculo! Él nos creó, ¡le pertenecemos! Mamá lo sabía, y conocía la necesidad de permanecer cerca, de hecho, unida al Buen Pastor, porque ella, la maternidad y la vida estaban, y están, bajo ataque. A veces la criticaban por tener tantos hijos, por ser madre de tantos. ¿Su respuesta? "¿A cuál debo devolver?". El Diablo odia a las mujeres, a las madres, al matrimonio, a las familias, a los bebés y a la vida; odia al Buen Pastor. Manténganse cerca de Jesús en el Sagrario. Por Él, con Él y en Él, estaremos seguros y alcanzaremos el pasto eterno en amor y alegría. No hay otra manera. ¡Feliz Domingo del Buen Pastor! ¡Feliz Día de la Madre! Y en las primeras palabras del Papa León XIV a la Iglesia y al mundo: "¡La paz sea con todos vosotros!"

Good Shepherd Sunday—4th Sunday of Easter

On many occasions I've heard non-Catholics object to the papacy. Often, they say something like this: "I just can't believe that one man on earth, the Pope, is holier than everyone else." So who ever said that being sinless is either a prerequisite or a consequence of being named Pope?

Pope, Successor of Peter

For the Pope, the bishop of Rome, is the successor of Peter, who spent the last years of his life leading the Christians of the eternal city. And here is an interesting fact. None of the four canonical gospels (not to mention Acts and Galatians) try to hide the fact that Peter sinned often and sinned big. By the way, if the "patriarchal, controlling" leaders of the early Catholic Church altered the story about Jesus as *The DaVinci Code* suggests, don't you think they would have "fixed" these embarrassing stories?

Name change from Simon to Peter

Yet while all agree Peter was weak and imperfect, they all also agree that he was given a unique responsibility. Only he got a name-change from Jesus himself (from Simon to "Peter" meaning rock). Only he was told by Christ on Holy Thursday night "I have prayed for you that your faith never fail and when you've repented, go and strengthen your brethren" (Lk 22: 31-32). And when Jesus, after the resurrection, cooked a fish breakfast for the apostles (Jn 21), it was only to Peter that Jesus put the question "do you love me?" But why did Jesus ask him the same question three times? Perhaps Peter needed to atone for his three-fold denial of Christ by a three-fold profession of love. Perhaps, given Peter's track record of getting it wrong, the Lord really wanted to be sure he got his point across. Here's the point—"Peter, your way of expressing penance for your sin and love for me will be to feed my sheep. Remember, they are not your sheep, but mine. Take care of them for me. Do for them what I did for them. Don't just feed them. Protect them. Lay down your life for them if you have to."

Pope as Universal Shepherd

Peter's role as a Shepherd is, in a way, unique because it is universal. Despite his human frailty, he is given care of all the Churches. And, if we take Luke 22:31-32 seriously, he is called to be the shepherd of all the shepherds. That's a big responsibility. In fact, it is a crushing burden which he could never fulfill on his own power. That's why we pray for the Pope (meaning "Papa" or father) in every Catholic Eucharist across the globe – He needs the grace of the Holy Spirit to fulfill his role. The bit about Peter stretching out his hands with others leading him where he does not want to go – it does not just refer to his crucifixion under Nero, but to the daily laying his life down for his flock, the "white martyrdom" that we saw so clearly in the weary but relentless witness of John Paul II.

Model for all Shepherds

In another way, though, Peter's role of a Shepherd is not unique. It is exemplary for all of us sheep who are called to become ourselves shepherds and leaders, despite our own frailty and sinfulness. Some are called to be bishops, successors of the apostles, entrusted with pastoral care of a portion of Christ's flock and of many brother-priests and deacons. Some are called to be priests and deacons, who assist a bishop in his apostolic mission. Some are called to be catechists, youth ministers and teachers, who assist in the feeding of the sheep.

And most of us are called to be parents, shepherds of what the Second Vatican Council calls "the domestic church." Parents, say St. Thomas Aquinas and John Paul II, have a pastoral role much like that of a parish priest. In fact John Paul II, in his letter *Familiaris Consortio*, says that the Catholic parent exercises "a true ministry of the Church."

On whatever level, the call to feed and care for the sheep is a call to sacrifice, not privilege. It has its moments of exaltation and profound satisfaction, but it has its moments of agony as well. But if we've learned anything from the passion, it's that suffering is the true and necessary test of love, as well as love's most authentic and powerful expression. So let us not be afraid to be shepherds. The Good Shepherd will empower us with His Spirit. And let's pray with gratitude and compassion for those who shepherd us.



Domingo del Buen Pastor — 4.º Domingo de Pascua

En muchas ocasiones he escuchado a no católicos objetar el papado. A menudo, dicen algo como: "No puedo creer que un hombre en la tierra, el Papa, sea más santo que todos los demás". Entonces, ¿quién dijo que ser impecable es un requisito o una consecuencia de ser nombrado Papa?

Papa, Sucesor de Pedro

Pues el Papa, obispo de Roma, es el sucesor de Pedro, quien pasó los últimos años de su vida guiando a los cristianos de la ciudad eterna. Y aquí hay un dato interesante: ninguno de los cuatro evangelios canónicos (por no hablar de Hechos y Gálatas) intenta ocultar que Pedro pecó a menudo y en gran medida. Por cierto, si los líderes "patriarcales y controladores" de la Iglesia Católica primitiva hubieran alterado la historia de Jesús como sugiere El Código Da Vinci, ¿no creen que habrían "arreglado" estas historias vergonzosas?

Cambio de Nombre de Simón a Pedro

Si bien todos coinciden en que Pedro era débil e imperfecto, también coinciden en que recibió una responsabilidad única. Solo él recibió un cambio de nombre de Jesús (de Simón a "Pedro", que significa roca). Solo él recibió la palabra de Cristo la noche del Jueves Santo: «He rogado por ti para que tu fe nunca desfallezca, y cuando te hayas arrepentido, ve y confirma a tus hermanos» (Lc 22, 31-32). Y cuando Jesús, después de la resurrección, preparó un desayuno de pescado para los apóstoles (Jn 21), fue solo a Pedro a quien le preguntó: «¿Me amas?».

Pero ¿por qué Jesús le hizo la misma pregunta tres veces? Quizás Pedro necesitaba expiar su triple negación de Cristo con una triple profesión de amor. Quizás, dado el historial de errores de Pedro, el Señor realmente quería asegurarse de que entendiera su mensaje. Este es el punto: «Pedro, tu forma de expresar tu penitencia por tu pecado y tu amor por mí será apacentar mis ovejas. Recuerda, no son tus ovejas, sino mías. Cuídalas por mí. Haz por ellas lo que yo hice por ellas. No solo las alimento. Protégelas. Da tu vida por ellas si es necesario».

El Papa como Pastor Universal

El rol de Pedro como Pastor es, en cierto modo, único por su carácter universal. A pesar de su fragilidad humana, se le confía el cuidado de todas las Iglesias. Y, si tomamos en serio Lucas 22:31-32, está llamado a ser el pastor de todos los pastores. Es una gran responsabilidad. De hecho, es una carga abrumadora que jamás podría cumplir por sí solo. Por eso oramos por el Papa (que significa "Papa" o padre) en cada Eucaristía católica del mundo: necesita la gracia del Espíritu Santo para cumplir su función. El pasaje sobre Pedro extendiendo las manos, junto con otros, para guiarlo adonde no quiere ir, no se refiere solo a su crucifixión bajo Nerón, sino a la entrega diaria de su vida por su rebaño, el "martirio blanco" que vimos tan claramente en el testimonio cansado pero incansable de Juan Pablo II.

Modelo para Todos los Pastores

Sin embargo, en otro sentido, el rol de Pedro como pastor no es único. Es un ejemplo para todas las ovejas que estamos llamadas a convertirnos en pastores y líderes, a pesar de nuestra propia fragilidad y pecaminosidad. Algunos están llamados a ser obispos, sucesores de los apóstoles, encargados del cuidado pastoral de una parte del rebaño de Cristo y de muchos hermanos sacerdotes y diáconos. Otros están llamados a ser sacerdotes y diáconos, quienes asisten al obispo en su misión apostólica. Otros están llamados a ser catequistas, pastores juveniles y maestros, quienes ayudan a alimentar a las ovejas.

Y la mayoría de nosotros estamos llamados a ser padres, pastores de lo que el Concilio Vaticano II llama «la iglesia doméstica». Los padres, dicen Santo Tomás de Aquino y Juan Pablo II, tienen un rol pastoral muy similar al de un párroco. De hecho, Juan Pablo II, en su carta Familiaris Consortio, afirma que el padre católico ejerce «un verdadero ministerio de la Iglesia».

En cualquier nivel, el llamado a alimentar y cuidar a las ovejas es un llamado al sacrificio, no al privilegio. Tiene sus momentos de exaltación y profunda satisfacción, pero también sus momentos de agonía. Pero si algo hemos aprendido de la Pasión, es que el sufrimiento es la verdadera y necesaria prueba del amor, así como su expresión más auténtica y poderosa. Así que no tengamos miedo de ser pastores. El Buen Pastor nos fortalecerá con su Espíritu. Y oremos con gratitud y compasión por quienes nos pastorean.

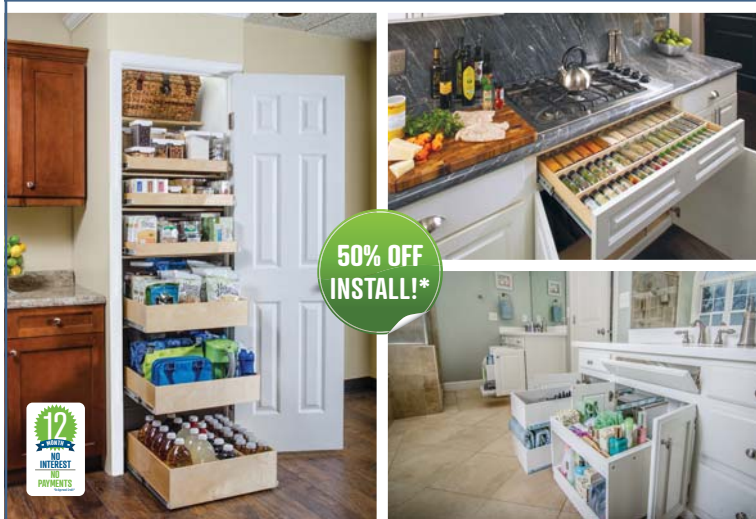

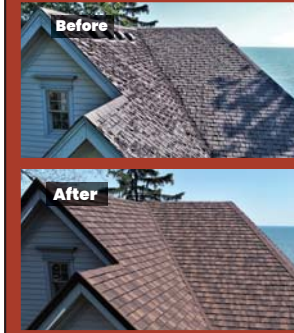
