Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Corpus Christi! God is so good, and so good to us! We had a full Chapel last Wednesday night for a beautiful Bilingual Mass in which we welcomed Our Lady of Guadalupe. The copy of the Tilma is special. It came from Mexico City and was touched to the case of the Tilma itself and blessed there as well by the Rector of the Basilica. As soon as the framed image arrived the week before, I sensed a change here. I believe Our Lady of Guadalupe really wanted to come here to bring us closer to Jesus. It's the same sense I have had since my first of several visits to the Shrine there in Mexico City (I'll be leading a pilgrimage there again in September). On my very first visit there 20 years ago, I could not bring myself to leave, so strong was the sense of her presence and that of Jesus there! She has come to the Chapel bearing gifts, so come and be bold in your petitions!

Here are Mary's first words to Juan Diego, on December 9, 1531: "Know, know for sure my dearest and youngest son, that I am truly the ever perfect Holy Virgin Mary, who has the honor to be the Mother of the one true God for whom we all live, the Creator of people, the Lord of all around us and of what is close to us, the Lord of Heaven, the Lord of Earth»" "I want very much that they build my sacred little house here, in which I will show Him, I will exalt Him on making Him manifest, I will give Him to all people in all my personal love, Him that is my compassionate gaze, Him that is my help, Him that is my salvation'." "Because truly I am honored to be your compassionate mother, yours and that of all the people that live together in this land, and also of all the other various lineages of men; those who love me, those who cry to me, those who seek me, those who trust in me. Because there truly will I hear their cry, their sadness, to remedy, to cure all their various troubles, their miseries, their pains'."" Her message is so rich, and chiefly because she brings us her Son, Jesus Christ. May Our Lady of Guadalupe help us to love, honor and serve Jesus in the Eucharist this Corpus Christi and forever! ¡Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe! ¡Viva Cristo Rey!

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

¡Feliz fiesta de Corpus Christi! ¡Dios es tan bueno y tan bueno con nosotros! Tuvimos una capilla llena el miércoles pasado por la noche para una hermosa misa bilingüe en la que recibimos a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. La copia de la Tilma es especial. Vino de la Ciudad de México y fue tocada al estuche de la Tilma misma y bendecida allí también por el Rector de la Basílica. Tan pronto como llegó la imagen enmarcada la semana anterior, sentí un cambio aquí. Creo que Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe realmente quería venir aquí para acercarnos a Jesús. Es la misma sensación que he tenido desde mi primera de varias visitas al Santuario allí en la Ciudad de México (lideraré una peregrinación allí nuevamente en septiembre). En mi primera visita allí hace 20 años, no podía irme, ¡tan fuerte era la sensación de su presencia y la de Jesús allí! Ella ha venido a la Capilla trayendo regalos, así que ¡vengan y sean valientes en sus peticiones!

Estas son las primeras palabras de María a Juan Diego, el 9 de diciembre de 1531: «Sabe, sabe con certeza, mi querido y pequeño hijo, que soy verdaderamente la

siempre perfecta Santísima Virgen María, que tiene el honor de ser la Madre del único Dios verdadero por quien todos vivimos, el Creador de los hombres, el Señor de todo lo que nos rodea y de lo que está cerca de nosotros, el Señor del Cielo, el Señor de la Tierra». «Deseo mucho que construyan aquí mi pequeña casa sagrada, en la que lo mostraré, lo exaltaré al manifestarlo, lo daré a todos los hombres con todo mi amor personal, a Él que es mi mirada compasiva, Él que es mi ayuda, Él que es mi salvación». "Porque en verdad me honra ser tu madre compasiva, la tuya y la de todos los pueblos que conviven en esta tierra, y también la de todos los demás linajes humanos; los que me aman, los que me claman, los que me buscan, los que confían en mí. Porque allí escucharé su llanto, su tristeza, para remediar, para curar todas sus diversas angustias, sus miserias, sus dolores". Su mensaje es tan rico, y principalmente porque nos trae a su Hijo, Jesucristo. ¡Que Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe nos ayude a amar, honrar y servir a Jesús en la Eucaristía este Corpus Christi y por siempre! ¡Viva la Virgen de Guadalupe! ¡Viva Cristo Rey!

Blessed Sacrament Chaplet

This Chaplet consists of a medal of the Blessed Sacrament and 33 beads. The 33 beads represent the 33 years of Christ's life on earth.

On the medal make a spiritual communion as follows:

My Jesus, I believe that thou art present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

I love thee above all things.

I desire to receive thee into my soul.

Since I cannot now receive thee sacramentally, come, at least, spiritually into my heart.

I embrace thee, and I unite myself entirely to thee, as if thou hadst already come;

do not permit me to be ever separated from thee. Amen.

On each bead pray: Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, have mercy on us.

End this chaplet with the "Act of Faith in the Eucharist":

O my God, I firmly believe that Thou art really and corporally present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar.

I adore Thee here present from the depths of my heart, and I worship Thy sacred Presence with all possible humility.

O my soul, what joy to have Jesus Christ always with us, and to be able to speak to Him, heart to Heart, with all confidence.

Grant, O Lord, that I, having adored Thy Divine Majesty here on earth in this wonderful Sacrament, may be able to adore It eternally in heaven. Amen.

Coronilla del Santísimo Sacramento

Appeal to Help Children with Autism in Nyeri, Kenya

The Archdiocese of Nyeri has a lot of needs as it continues the work of evangelization that goes hand in hand with charitable works to serve the people who are both spiritually and physically in need. Archbishop Anthony Muheria of Nyeri has focused on projects that are geared toward alleviation of poverty and the problems that are affecting our people in the areas of health, lack of education, and development. In the past years he has focused on among other projects, in building and maintaining a rehabilitation center for those who suffer from addictions (alcohol and drug). While this project is still work in progress there are other issues that require urgent attention. Another most urgent problem that has been always there but the archbishop has made it a priority is that of children who are born with autism. This category of human beings is not well understood in Kenya and are left to the mercy of their mothers to feed them, educate them and take care of them throughout their lives. We single out the mothers because in many cases where a child is born with autism, fathers move out of their lives and they are taken care of by their mothers who become single mothers with other children to take care of. Within the territory of the Archdiocese of Nyeri there are no schools or facilities that cater for the children with autism. Some attend school with regular students but they suffer from discrimination and bullying. Archbishop Anthony Muheria has been visiting villages and organizing seminars to bring awareness to the villagers and society at large of the need to take special care for children with autism. He would like to start a school or facility that would take care of children with autism but he needs funds to accomplish this most worthy project. It is for this reason that he requests your parish's generosity in giving money as a second collection this weekend that will support starting programs in aid of children with autism. The money raised from your parish will be used only towards this project.

We are most grateful to your Pastor, Rev. Jeremy Paulin, OMV who by inviting us to preach in your parish is extending his pastoral hand not only to the people of Saint Francis Chapel, but to vulnerable children far away in Africa. As we pray for your positive response to our humble request, we pray for the Lord to continue blessing you for your generosity. In responding to our call, you are joining the Church's answer to the Divine call of the Heavenly Master, to cure the sick, feed the hungry and declare to all that the Kingdom of God is at hand. Thank you for your compassion.




