

New Tiny Saints Forerunners!

Reflection by Fr. Jeremy Paulin, OMV

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In these current weeks we are celebrating lots of great Saints in the Church, including St Ignatius of Loyola, on July 31. What follows is taken from his autobiography, and speaks about his conversion while recovering from terrible wounds received in battle in Pamplona, Spain in 1521.

"Ignatius was passionately fond of reading worldly books of fiction and tales of knight-errantry. When he felt he was getting better, he asked for some of these books to pass the time. But no book of that sort could be found in the house; instead they gave him a life of Christ and a collection of the lives of saints written in Spanish. By constantly reading these books he began to be attracted to what he found narrated there. Sometimes in the midst of his reading he would reflect on what he had read. Yet at other times he would dwell on many of the things which he had been accustomed to dwell on previously. But at this point our Lord came to his assistance, insuring that these thoughts were followed by others which arose from his current reading.

While reading the life of Christ our Lord or the lives of the saints, he would reflect and reason with himself: "What if I should do what Saint Francis or Saint Dominic did?" In this way he let his mind dwell on many thoughts; they lasted a while until other things took their place. Then those vain and worldly images would come into his mind and remain a long time. This sequence of thoughts persisted with him for a long time.

But there was a difference. When Ignatius reflected on worldly thoughts, he felt intense pleasure; but when he gave them up out of weariness, he felt dry and depressed. Yet when he thought of living the rigorous sort of life he knew the saints had lived, he not only experienced pleasure when he actually thought about it, but even after he dismissed these thoughts, he still experienced great joy. Yet he did not pay attention to this, nor did he appreciate it until one day, in a moment of insight, he began to marvel at the difference. Then he understood his experience: thoughts of one kind left him sad, the others full of joy. And this was the first time he applied a process of reasoning to his religious experience. Later on, when he began to formulate his spiritual exercises, he used this experience as an illustration to explain the doctrine he taught his disciples on the discernment of spirits."

There are many lessons to be had from his life...how God can reach us through setbacks and suffering, our choices in what we read and watch, and discernment. In the chapel gift shop we offer many titles on prayer and the Christian life based on the teachings of St Ignatius, many of them by our own Fr Timothy Gallagher, OMV. Great reading for transformation and the opening of our spiritual eyes! St. Ignatius, pray for us!


"Ignacio era un apasionado de la lectura de libros mundanos de ficción y relatos de caballería andante. Cuando sintió que mejoraba, pidió algunos de estos libros para pasar el tiempo. Pero no se encontró ningún libro de ese tipo en la casa; en su lugar, le dieron una vida de Cristo y una colección de vidas de santos escritas en español. Continúa en la página siguiente

Al leer constantemente estos libros, comenzó a sentirse atraído por lo que allí se narraba. A veces, en medio de su lectura, reflexionaba sobre lo que había leído. Sin embargo, en otras ocasiones, se detenía en muchas de las cosas en las que solía detenerse anteriormente. Pero en este punto nuestro Señor vino en su ayuda, asegurando que estos pensamientos fueran seguidos por otros que surgieran de su lectura actual.

Al leer la vida de Cristo nuestro Señor o la de los santos, reflexionaba y razonaba consigo mismo: "¿Y si hiciera lo que hicieron San Francisco o Santo Domingo?". De esta manera, dejaba que su mente se detuviera en muchos pensamientos; estos persistían un tiempo hasta que otras cosas los reemplazaban. Entonces, esas imágenes vanas y mundanas acudían a su mente y permanecían allí por mucho tiempo. Esta secuencia de pensamientos persistió en él durante mucho tiempo.

Pero había una diferencia. Cuando Ignacio reflexionaba sobre pensamientos mundanos, sentía un intenso placer; pero cuando los abandonaba por cansancio, se sentía seco y deprimido. Sin embargo, cuando pensaba en vivir la vida rigurosa que sabía que habían vivido los santos, no solo experimentaba placer al pensarla, sino que incluso después de desecharlos, experimentaba una gran alegría. Sin embargo, no le prestó atención ni lo apreció hasta que un día, en un momento de comprensión, comenzó a maravillarse de la diferencia. Entonces comprendió su experiencia: algunos pensamientos lo dejaban triste, otros lo llenaban de alegría. Y esta fue la primera vez que aplicó un proceso de razonamiento a su experiencia religiosa. Más tarde, cuando comenzó a formular sus ejercicios espirituales, utilizó esta experiencia como ilustración para explicar la doctrina que enseñaba a sus discípulos sobre el discernimiento de espíritus."

Su vida nos enseña muchas lecciones: cómo Dios puede alcanzarnos a través de los reveses y el sufrimiento, nuestras decisiones sobre lo que leemos y vemos, y el discernimiento. En la tienda de regalos de la capilla ofrecemos numerosos títulos sobre la oración y la vida cristiana basados en las enseñanzas de San Ignacio, muchos de ellos escritos por nuestro Padre Timothy Gallagher, OMV. ¡Una lectura excelente para la transformación y la apertura espiritual! ¡San Ignacio, ruega por nosotros!




